Annual Report Executive Summary for Fiscal Year 2022

The mission of the MCCB is to advance the community college system through coordination, support, leadership, and advocacy. We work closely with our fifteen community colleges as they provide a first-rate education at an affordable cost to many thousands of Mississippians.

During FY 2022, the agency consisted of seven divisions: Executive; Finance and Administration; Programs and Accountability; Academic and Student Affairs; Workforce, Career and Technical Education; Information Services; and Research and Planning. The Mississippi Community College Board and the community colleges accomplished the following:

Research and Planning:

- Fall 2021 Credit Enrollment: 63,959 students.
- Academic transfer enrollment accounted for 57% of total credit enrollment in the fall of 2021.
- Spring 2022 Credit Enrollment: 56,768 students.
- Academic transfer enrollment accounted for 54% of total credit enrollment in the fall of 2021.

Finance and Administration:

- Administered a budget of approximately \$59.2 million for the MCCB.
- State General Funds accounted for 9.1% of revenues for the MCCB.
- Federal sources accounted for 13.8% of revenues for the MCCB.
- Allocated and disbursed appropriated state funds to the fifteen public community and junior colleges. State support flow-through funds totaled approximately \$241.5 million in FY 2022.

Academic and Student Affairs:

- 3,875 students were enrolled in Smart Start with the following outcomes: 2,210 earned a Smart Start credential; 2,801 earned a National Career Readiness Certificate; 887 earned a high school equivalency diploma; 656 earned one or more component of their high school equivalency; and 253 enrolled in either postsecondary education or training.

- 34 new or renewed certificates of registration were issued in FY 2022 for proprietary schools.

Career-Technical Education:

- 4 requests for new programs were received from three institutions, and all were approved.
- 11 requests for a new program option were received from eight colleges, and both were approved.
- 11 requests for a new program location were received from eight institutions, and all were approved.
