REASON FOR EXCEEDING MAXIMUM MILLIAGE AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 37-29-141:

EAST CENTRAL - E&I at East Central CC includes a Special Tax Levy for Dorm Loan Payment from Winston County in the amount of \$41,643.

EAST MISSISSIPPI - Lauderdale County is providing a special levy of \$50,000 for Debt Service to EMCC, which is included in E&I above. Other counties providing a special levy for debt services include Clay for \$199,603 or 1.75 mills, Kemper for \$111,302 or 1.0 mills, Lowndes for \$325,000 or .6 mills, Noxubee for \$120,461 or 2.56 mills, and Oktibbeha for \$230,535 or .75 mills.

HOLMES - The City of Ridgeland provides an additional \$11,000 for Maintenance. This amount is not included above.

ITAWAMBA - Maintenance at Itawamba CC includes extra millage per Section 37-35-3 for the establishment and maintenance of adult education classes in the amount of 1.0 or \$124,434 from Itawamba County, 0.27 or \$93,931 from Lee County for ABE, 0.13 or \$39,759 from Monroe, 0.40 or \$61,986 from Pontotoc. In addition, under maintenance ICC receives a levy of 0.90 or \$724,045 from Lee County for the Vocational Training Center. Under E&I, Itawamba Co. has added 1.0 extra mill or \$122,243 and Lee Co. 1.28 mills or \$226,957, per Section 27-39-329 for debt service.

JONES COUNTY - Under Maintenance Greene County provides \$79,931 and Jasper County provides \$192,454 or 1.0 mill for Tuition Assistance.

MERIDIAN - Maintenance at Meridian CC includes extra millage per Section 37-35-3 for the establishment and maintenance of adult education classes in the amount of 1.0 mill or \$317,812 from the City of Meridian.

MISSISSIPPI DELTA - Issaquena under Capital Improvements provides \$10,240 or 0.50 mills; Sunflower provides 0.50 mills or \$86,402 for support of the Student Union Center and Washington provides 0.20 mills or \$77,052 in support.

MISS. GULF COAST - Section 37-29-437 allows MGCCC additional millage; The following Counties levied additional amounts for District Bonds Debt Service: George County - \$147,721; Harrison County - \$1,830,580; Jackson County - \$753,087; and Stone County \$165,100. In addition, under E&I additional amounts for a DEQ Loan were made by George County - \$9,464; Harrison County - \$9,464, and Jackson/Stone County \$18,929;

NORTHWEST - Calhoun provides \$3,651 for tuition assistance and Lafayette provides \$34,921 for tuition assistance and Marshall provides \$9,200 for tuition assistance.

SOUTHWEST- Southwest MS CC received a levy of 0.03 or \$10,000 under E&I additional amounts for Regional Workforce Training Center from Pike County.
